



HISTORY

Bucharest was first mentioned in documents as early as **1459**. Along with the passage of time it has gone through a variety of changes, becoming the state capital of the country in **1862** and steadily stabilizing its position as the core of the Romanian mass media, culture and arts. Its eclectic architecture is a mix of historical (neo-classical), interbellum (Bauhaus and Art Deco) bearing Communist and modern influences. In the period between the two World Wars, the city's elegant architecture and the sophistication of its elite earned Bucharest the nickname of the "**Little Paris of the East**" (Micul Paris).

LOCATION

The Grand Hotel Continental is located on Calea Victoriei, a place full of history, the center of Bucharest high life since the 1800's. The building itself exists since 1886 and has passed through a recent restoration, preserving the same classic structure and details.

The National Art Museum is located just a few steps away from the hotel, whereas the Atheneum is in range of a few minutes' walking distance.

The National Theatre and the University are just at a stone's throw.

The music lovers can visit The **George Enescu Museum** hosted in the **Cantacuzino Palace**, one of the most sumptuous buildings in Bucharest.

The History Museum finds itself on Calea Victoriei just opposite to the headquarters

of the oldest Romanian bank – the **C.E.C.** (Casa de Economii și Consemnațiuni) – located in a beautiful palace built in eclectic style with a glass and metal dome.

The Cişmigiu Garden (Parcul Cişmigiu) is a public park near the center of Bucharest, spanning areas on all sides of an artificial lake. The gardens' creation was an important moment in the history of Bucharest. They form the oldest and, at 17 hectares, the largest park in city's central area. The main entrance is from Regina Elisabeta Boulevard, in front of the City Hall; there is another major entrance at the Ştirbei Vodă Street, near the Crețulescu Palace.

The Palace Hall (Sala Palatului) in Bucharest, is a conference centre and concert hall immediately behind The National Museum of Art of Romania, the former Royal Palace in the heart of the city. It was built between 1959 and 1960, during the communist era. It has been the site of conferences such as the United Nations Economic Commission for Europe, the World Congress on Population, the World Congress on Energy, and the World Congress of the Red Cross. The main hall can accommodate 4,060 spectators.

The International Airport Henri Coanda can be reached by car in 40 - 60 minutes (15 km).
