What is AEDBF/ESBFL?

The Association Européenne pour le Droit Bancaire et Financier / European Society for Banking and Financial Law is a non-profit interdisciplinary scientific association, established in Paris in June of 1988 with the aim of bringing together university professors, supervisory authorities, magistrates, exponents from the financial world and economic-legal counsels who are interested in discussing issues around banking and financial law in a European context.

The Society adopted a federal model and consequently some affiliated national societies were set up in the countries where AEDBF/ESBFL is more active.

During the years, the Society has organised a number of conferences, whose proceedings have been published from local editors, and many seminars and post-graduate training programmes.

More recently, AEDBF/ESBFL has paid great attention to innovation in the financial sector. The many examples of such attention include two conferences that were organised in 2016 and 2018 dedicated respectively to "The end of the banking monopolies?" and to "Currencies".
